The Firebird was powered by a 455 cubic inch V8 engine. The reported 310 hp was widely understood to be a made up number to appease safety regulations when in fact it was certainly much higher. Also featured are Pontiac's iconic Honeycomb wheels, designed to provide a distinctive, performance-oriented look deserving of the Firebird. These cast-aluminum wheels became a hallmark of the Trans Am. The wheels, along with its distinctive wide body and aggressive stance, made it a standout both on and off the track.
